Every year Paly's Robotics Team 8 participates in several highly visible and acclaimed FIRST Robotics competitions. Team 8 is a student-led organization: the robot for each competition season is designed, built, and programmed entirely by Paly students. But Team 8 is more than robotics—the Business and Art Teams are significant parts of the team.

The Art Team is comprised of four smaller departments: Animation, Graphic Design, Photography, and Sketching and Storytelling.
